**Aim for the Regents' Scholarship!**

**Here's what you need to do:**

- Take the right classes in grades 9-12
- Earn at least a 3.3 cumulative GPA
- Earn at least a composite score of 22 on the ACT
- Meet college enrollment or deferment requirements
- Fill out the FAFSA (*Free Application for Federal Student Aid*)
- Meet all deadlines
- Graduate from a Utah high school

**Take the following during grades 9-12:**

- ✓ 4 credits of English
- ✓ 4 credits of Mathematics
- ✓ 3.5 credits of Social Science
- ✓ 3 credits of lab-based Science, with one each of Biology, Chemistry, and Physics
- ✓ 2 progressive credits of the same World Language (other than English)

**Award info:**

Award amounts vary and are subject to funding. You can qualify for more scholarship dollars based on financial need as determined by the FAFSA. To earn additional dollars based on saving through a UESP account and to maximize the award, you must be the beneficiary of the account and deposit \$100 or more when you are 14, 15, 16, and 17.
