

Want to prepare for college and qualify for a scholarship at the same time?



Planning Guide for 2019 HS Graduates

Aim for the Regents' Scholarship!

Here's what you need to do:

- Take the right classes in grades 9-12
- Earn at least a 3.3 cumulative GPA
- Earn at least a composite score of 22 on the ACT
- Meet college enrollment or deferment requirements
- Fill out the FAFSA (*Free Application for Federal Student Aid*)
- Meet all deadlines
- Graduate from a Utah high school
- Meet citizenship requirements

Take the following during grades 9-12:

- ✓ 4 credits of English
- ✓ 4 credits of Mathematics
- ✓ 3 credits of Social Science
- ✓ 3 credits of lab-based Science, with one each of Biology, Chemistry, and Physics
- ✓ 2 credits of the same World Language (other than English)

Award info:

Every student who meets the requirements for the scholarship can receive a one-time award. Award amounts will be determined annually based on available funding. Additional scholarship funds may be available to students who have a gap in their ability to cover basic college costs, as determined by the college where the student is enrolled and available funding. The student's expected family contribution (as determined by the FAFSA) as well as other aid a student is receiving will be considered. These funds can be used for up to two years, as long as the student completes 30 credits per year and maintains a 3.0 GPA.

A student can earn additional scholarship funds if they are the beneficiary of a UESP account. UESP will match contributions of \$100 each year when the student is 14, 15, and 16.
